To share with the whole class (do not label, please)

- 1 large glue stick
- 1 pack of 3 "Magic Rub" or other soft pencil erasers
- 2 large containers of premoistened cleaning (not diaper) wipes

To keep in your child's desk (please label these with your child's name)

- 1 soft zippered pouch for desk supplies containing:
 - 1 set of 12 high quality, full length colored pencils
 - 1 pair of child's scissors (Fiskars are preferred)
 - 1 small zip-lock type bag that fastens securely, labeled with your child's name, containing 4 quarters, 10 dimes, 20 nickels, and twenty-five pennies. (This change is an important part of math lessons throughout the year. It will come back home.)
- 5 **pocket** folders (one each: red, yellow, green, blue, purple)
- One fancy or shiny pocket folder (child's choice) for homework, clearly labeled on the front with your child's name
- 1- 1" three-ring binder, clearly labeled with "Geography" and your child's name
- 3 spiral-bound notebooks; no more than 100 pages each, labeled on the front with your child's name;
 - label one "Math Journal"
 - label one "Language Arts Journal"

NOTE: Your child does NOT need pencils for school this year. The students will be provided with pencils for classroom use. Please make sure your child has a book bag/backpack to carry papers and other items to and from school. Because the storage space is quite small, please **DO NOT SEND** large backpacks, backpacks with wheels, etc. Also, **please do not send a pencil box.** A soft zippered bag for colored pencils is much quieter! Second-graders may wear analog watches only; digital watches will be kept in lockers or backpacks. As you may have gathered, telling time and understanding money are major topics in second grade math!

We have a snack time before morning recess each day. If your child chooses to snack, please keep it simple and nutritious. Your child may choose to keep a weekly supply of something non-perishable at school (nuts, granola bars, pretzels, or crackers, for example), or may pack something such as fruit daily. (We often eat during math time, so messy snacks are not preferred!) You will need to provide spoons, straws, napkins, etc. needed for snacks, as well as for any lunches packed at home. The lunch program provides these for those who order lunch.
